To be eligible prisoners must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Receive no visitsfrom near relatives in the previous 4 weeks;</li> <li>- Have no near relatives either permanently or temporarily resident in the UK;</li> <li>- Have a near relative that resides in a country outside the UK.</li> </ul> <p>Foreign National prisoners may access Embassy or Consularadvice through normal channels. SPS provides a translation service and produces its communications in multiple languages.</p>
